The association Stand Speak Rise Up! was created following the international conference against rape as a weapon of war and against sexual violence in sensitive areas, which brought together 50 survivors and more than 1,200 people in Luxembourg on 26 and 27 March 2019, at the initiative of Her Royal Highness the Grand Duchess of Luxembourg.

Since then, the association has been organizing meetings and exhibitions to raise public awareness of this issue and the fate of Survivors. In addition to its advocacy role, the association supports concrete projects for the economic empowerment of Survivors throughout the world.

Since its creation in 1981, The Foundation of The Grand Duke and The Grand Duchess has been working to promote the social integration of vulnerable people. The association Stand Speak Rise Up!

The use of rape as a weapon of war is a silenced issue, which makes it a time bomb that fragments societies and prevents the emergence of long-lasting peace.

Stand Speak Rise Up! aims to denounce rape as a weapon of war, prevent its proliferation, and support victims in their work of reconstruction and their need for justice. It acts as a «megaphone» for the victims but also for the bearers of solutions. It organizes regular meetings on specific topics, inviting both survivors and international experts.

The purpose is to draw up factual observations, propose solutions and influence international authorities to change the situation. The association's scope of work has been structured around several topics directly defined during the first forum in Luxembourg with both Survivors and specialists:

- healing physical and psychological wounds;
- ending the stigma for victims;
- unifying rules and laws for justice;
- repairing harm/losses/prejudices;
- developing technology and finance for the benefit of victims;
- improving the inclusion of children born of rape.

The initiative Stand Speak Rise Up! is a call to national and international organizations, representants and civil society to support its cause and strengthen the capacities to act. To put an end to the impunity of sexual crimes masterminds in sensitive areas should be an international priority!



KNOWING THE SYSTEM TO FIX IT

Create conditions for a better understanding of mechanisms and root causes of sexual violence in sensitive areas. This line addresses the systematic and structural aspects of sexual violence and its long-term socio-economic impacts on individuals, families, and the next generations.

Through their networking activities, our President, HRH the Grand-Duchess of Luxembourg, and the other members of the Board of Directors exchange and share information and contacts but also connect those who have the expertise and answers with those who have the power and means to support solutions in the field, at a regional and international scale.



STRONG AND NOT SILENCED

Give a voice and a platform to Survivors' communities; amplify their international visibility; recognize their pain and strength.

We support the Survivors' community by providing them with financial means to get organized into associations that give them a voice but also help them create the necessary momentum for empowerment. Through their reintegration into local economic life, Survivors gain recognition in their communities and can meet their family's needs. It is important to listen and spread Survivors' words!

We use social media to share their stories and empower Survivors to participate in regional and international conferences. Many Survivors who participated in the Luxembourg forum became advocates because international leaders listened to them and recognized the pain and the need for legal and financial reparations.

Through advocacy on behalf of Survivors, the association pushes their voices up on the international stage. Our role is to help them in their advocacy work, giving them the means to be heard and, above all, to be listened to. This role remains the first motivation of our President, H.R.H. the Grand Duchess.

UNITED FOR ACTION

Connecting stakeholders to facilitate concrete actions; by bringing together civil society, NGOs, companies, governments, supranational institutions, medical and health care professionals, financial institutions, lawyers, Survivors networks and other humanitarian actors.

We want to raise awareness of the daily impact that everyone can have as an informed consumer. Sharing good practices allows citizens to help on a financial way, by sharing content on social medias, but also by getting directly involved in their local grocery shop. Buying and consuming certified products guarantees that the raw materials are sourced and produced in a way that respects human rights, without resorting to sexual violence in any form. That can be achieved through consuming fair-trade chocolate or coffee, staying in a responsible hotel (raising awareness of human beings trafficking), or buying certified jewellery.

Gathering public figures around a cause

BACK UP PROJECT WE ARE NOT WEAPONS OF WAR

In March 2019, during the Forum, The Foundation of The Grand Duke and The Grand Duchess committed to Céline Bardet and the association We are NOT Weapons of War to set up the "BackUp" application. This webpage allows the reporting of victims of war rape, the coordination of professionals involved in this issue, and the collection of reliable data. Thanks to the forum, WWoW was able to meet other investors. In March 2022, the application is urgently deployed in the context of the war in Ukraine and still requires financial support for its development, maintenance and the field monitoring that this implies.



SUPPORT TO THE **PANZI FOUNDATION** IN FAVOUR OF THE ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN

The international Forum initiated several projects in favour of the **Panzi Foundation**. This foundation, created by **Dr. Mukwege** at the hospital in Bukavu (DRC), aims to take care of victims of sexual violence with a holistic approach: medical care, psycho-social follow-up, social reintegration, and legal support. Stand Speak Rise Up! has initiated collaborations for the benefit of Panzi, notably with the **Engie Foundation**, the **Luxembourg Red Cross** and **La Guilde du Raid** during the COVID crisis. Today, Stand Speak Rise Up! is still committed to working with the Panzi Foundation to help the survivors with concrete projects to contribute to their reintegration and economic empowerment.

EMERGENCY PROJECT DEDICATED TO UKRAINIANS SURVIVORS

2022

Since the beginning of the armed invasion of Ukraine by Russia in 2022, many testimonies have been received attesting to the sexual violence committed against Ukrainian women and girls. Stand Speak Rise Up! commits itself to Ukrainian women whether they are in Ukraine, on their way to a safer place or in Luxembourg. In order to respond to their needs, Stand Speak Rise Up! is setting up a holistic project with local partners helping them in three areas: legal, medical/psychological and material.



DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

2020 Support to Survivors in the Kabare territory, livestock breeding, planting of vegetables and protective equipment for 40 survivors during 6 months, through the Mouvement des Survivant.e.s de Viols et de Violences Sexuelles en RDC.

2021 The project continues during a year with 60 survivors more in Goma.

2022 Based on the results, the project is being extended for one year with 100 survivors in agriculture and 30 survivors in fish farming.
