On the occasion of the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women, H.R.H. Grand Duchess Maria Teresa of Luxembourg and Chékéba Hachemi, co-founders of Stand Speak Rise Up! and co-editors-in-chief, presented in the Salle des Pas Perdus of the Luxembourg Court of Justice the new Stand Speak Rise Up! Multidisciplinary Review, dedicated to sexual violence in conflict and post-conflict settings.
